Faith can overcome fear and doubt.

A quiet but genuine faith can empower us to overcome injustice and sorrow. When we allow God to speak to us in the words of our everyday lives, we can find the strength to follow His will. It is the fear and doubt we allow to enter our consciousness that defeats us.

In today's reading, Elijah recognizes God in the whispering sound. In the second reading, Paul shares his sorrow that his own people, the Israelites, the ones God had chosen, are not accepting Christ. In the Gospel, Peter joins Jesus walking on the water. When Peter's fear shifts his focus off Jesus, he begins to sink.

CHANGES IN THE MASS

Beginning First Sunday of Advent **You are hearing today**

Beginning the First Sunday of Advent of this year (**November 26/27, 2011**) the texts of the Mass that we say (and sing) will be changing. These texts are taken from a book called the Roman Missal. This will be the third edition of the Missal after Vatican II. The current translation (the second edition of the Roman Missal after Vatican II) was promulgated by Pope Paul VI in 1969 and approved by the National Conference of Catholic Bishops for use in the United States in 1973. The current translation is not a direct translation from the Latin and in some cases is missing a great deal of the beauty of the original Latin. Today you heard (after communion) the Cantor sing one of the new *Mysterium Fidei* (Latin for Mystery of Faith—from 1 Timothy 3:9). In the new Roman Missal there are three options to be sung (or said) by the faithful. “When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup we proclaim your Death, O Lord, until you come again.” This is very similar to what we sing (say) now—only three words are different “O Lord” instead of “Lord Jesus Christ” and “come again” instead of “come in glory”. This is to preserve the direct Biblical reference: 1 Corinthians 11:26. There are two other options: “We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again.” This too is based on 1 Corinthians 11:26. And “Save us, Savior of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection you have set us free.” (Taken from John 4:42) “Christ has died”, “Dying you destroyed our death”, and “Lord by your Cross and Resurrection” will no longer be used. These new texts are “action words”, “we proclaim your Death” and “Save us” rather than simple statements of faith. Notice too the focus of the new texts on the sacrifice of Jesus. These new texts will call us all to look deeper into our faith as we pray the mass in a new (yet ancient) way.



MISSION COOPERATIVE PLAN SPECIAL COLLECTION AUGUST 13TH AND 14TH, 2011

On the weekend of **August 13th/14th**, **Fr. Philip Pitya**, USA Mission Representative from the Archdiocese of Juba, the Republic of South Sudan will present to us an overview of his work in South Sudan. On July 9, 2011 South Sudan became an independent Nation State. On that day, Sudan separated into two nations: The Republic of South Sudan and the Islamic Republic of the Sudan in the North. Our Church, finding herself on the crossroad between the two countries, must continue to bear witness to Christ's reconciling Gospel of love and mercy. Our Church must be a voice of reason to the contending people of the two nations. A monumental task indeed! On the Evangelical and Pastoral Fronts, we are facing a flood of returning destitute refugees and internally displaced people to whom we must minister and proclaim the Gospel. Our Church must recruit and train many more clerical and lay pastoral agents. We must rebuild our churches, chapels, prayer centers, seminaries, convents, rectories, catechetical training centers, etc.

On the Socio-political Front, the Church is and will continue to play a vital leading role in building peace and advocating for justice, the equitable sharing of resources, good governance, security and the rule of law which must be built on the solid foundation of Christ's Gospel.

On the Socio-economic Front, the Church, in partnership with the government and other religious and social institutions, is providing a leading role in sheltering, feeding, healing and educating the citizens of our new Nation. We are promoting traditional and new economics-farming, small business and supplying clean drinking water to the people. We must rebuild our social institutions-schools, health centers, trade and technical training centers. Most of our facilities were damaged or totally destroyed during the long civil war.

Our people are desperate. They have lost everything, and are unable to help themselves. Many, particularly the most vulnerable children and the elderly, are dying daily from starvation and curable diseases.

We in the church are the hope for our people. Our clergy, religious, catechists and lay leaders are fighting against all odds to keep the flames of faith burning in our country. While burying the dead, supporting the survivors, sheltering the displaced, healing the wounded and broken hearted, feeding the orphans and displaced children, widows and the elderly, we continue to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ vigorously, build the Church and consolidate faith in our country.

We need your help to continue to keep hope alive along our traumatized people. I am therefore appealing to you, our brothers and sisters in faith to help us in our struggle for survival. Thank you in advance for standing in solidarity with us in our time of need. May our Risen Savior Jesus Christ bless you with the fullness of grace, peace and health.

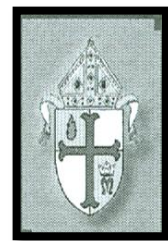

Parish Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima

The old Church of Saint Augustine contained a beautiful statue in honor of Our Lady of Fatima! A few years ago we started the tradition of having the Statue of Our Lady of Fatima being hosted in the homes of our parish families to further devotion to our Blessed Mother. **Every family** is invited to host the Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady! True devotion to our Blessed Mother always brings one closer to the Heart of her son!

The statue is approximately 3 feet tall and is hand-carved of wood, (light weight). The statue comes from Fatima, Portugal, where the Blessed Mother appeared to the three shepherd children, Lucy, Jacinta and Francesco. The apparitions took place in 1917 and the final apparition took place on October 13th. Our Lady encouraged devotion to her Immaculate Heart, to pray in reparation for sin, and to meditate on the Mysteries of the Rosary.
