

Dear St. Augustine Families,


We are proud to announce that we are now a Bing in the Classroom school. When a school signs up for Bing in the Classroom, they take all the ads out of Bing.com search results. Then they turn on SafeSearch with strict filtering, to help filter out adult content that doesn't belong in schools. And finally, they add enhanced privacy settings that prevent use of search data for

personalized ad profiles. Because students should be able to access the transformative power of search at school without having to worry that their searches will be used for ad profiling.

The second great feature about being a Bing in the Classroom school is that anyone can earn credits just by searching the web with Bing—similar to a frequent flyer program. Credits can be donated to help get free Microsoft Surface tablets for schools. It's easy! All you have to do is stay signed in as you search with Bing.
