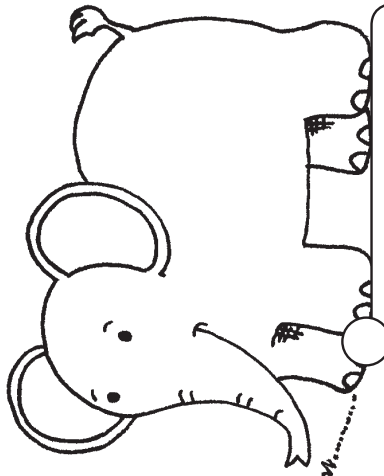
Read pages 1-4.

What happened over time?



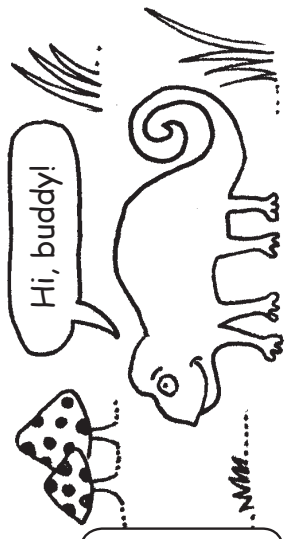
Read pages 7-10.
